The live bidding screen opens when you click on the link we will place on our homepage during the auction. When you click on this link, the following screen will appear when you're not already logged in or registered.

With your email address and password you will be able to log in. When you forgot your password, please click on 'Forgot your password?'. When this is the first time you participate in our online auction, please first register by clicking on 'register'. In the top right corner of the screen you can select the language setting (English/German/Dutch).

In the lower part of the screen you'll see closed and upcoming lots. Besides, you'll find information about your approved credit and an overview of your bids and purchases.

B. Frank heeft op 14 september 1874 de 'Theorie der Elektriciteit' in de 'Leipziger Allgemeine Zeitung' (LZ) gepubliceerd.

Deze publicatie is een belangrijke mijlpaal in de geschiedenis van de natuurkunde, omdat het de eerste keer is dat de elektrische veldtheorie wordt geformuleerd. Frank stelt hierin dat elektrische velden bestaan uit lijnen van elektrische spanning, die zich uitbreiden vanuit een puntbron. Deze lijnen worden later bekend als elektrische veldlijnen.

De publicatie heeft grote invloed gehad op de ontwikkeling van de elektrodynamica, met name op het werk van James Clerk Maxwell. Zijn vergelijkingen, die de relatie tussen elektrische velden, magnetische velden en licht beschrijven, zijn gebaseerd op de principes die Frank in 1874 heeft geformuleerd.
